KVS (HQ) has received request from Regional Offices for reviewing the conduct of Project based Supplementary Examination 2021-22 for class IX & XI, as some State Governments have opened the schools in physical mode and Session Ending Examinations for these classes are being conducted in physical mode. The matter has been examined at KVS(HQ) level and with the approval of the Competent Authority of KVS, the Project based assessment for Supplementary Examination for class IX and XI for the Academic Session 2021-22 has been modified as under:-

- 1. The Supplementary Examination will be conducted in written form and Project based assessment pattern is being withdrawn.
- 2. Questions will be set only from Term-II syllabus of the Class at Regional Level.
- 3. Pattern of examinations will be similar to Session Ending Examination (Term-II) 2021-22
- 4. The results of students will be declared on the basis of marks obtained in both Terms and marks of Supplementary Examination will replace with the marks of Term-II Session Ending Examination (SEE).

The other content of the previous letter dated 18.01.2022 will remain the same.

As you are aware, in the wake of COVID 19 pandemic almost all Kendriya Vidyalayas have functioned in virtual mode during the session 2021-2022. In view of the prevailing unprecedented situation CBSE has also changed the examination pattern and introduced Term wise Special Scheme of Assessment system for classes IX to XII for the session 2021-22. It was therefore felt that some relaxation and flexibility should be extended to the students of KVs in these extraordinary times. Accordingly, the Competent Authority of KVS has approved the following framework for conduct of Session Ending Examinations and promotion for the session 2021-22 -

- 5. Deputy Commissioners are requested to conduct VC with all Principals & Question paper Setters (expert teachers) of Class IX & XI about setting of Question Papers to avoid any issues.
- 6. During setting of questions paper teachers may be directed to ensure content coverage, accuracy, use of appropriate and correct language while framing the questions in order to avoid ambiguity. The moderations work may be taken up accordingly.
- 7. Blue Print for the Session Ending Examination, 2021-22 (Term-2) may be prepared at Regional level and circulated to all KVs in advance.

- 8. The platform for conducting examination should also be familiar/user friendly for students & teachers.

- 12. The sanctity and confidentiality of Examination Process must be ensured.

The class teachers may be the Nodal teacher for assigning the project out of the lists and models developed by the team of teachers teaching a particular class. The review may be done periodically to ensure that it is a continuous ongoing process and not a term end review. The assessment will be done two times; once before the mid-term to see the progress and finally before the SEE. One exemplar of MDPfor each class is given as annexure for reference only.

Note: Autonomy should be given to the child for the selection of topic. One exemplar for each class is given however, the teacher will have autonomy to decide as to whether it is to be given individually or in group. The assessment rubrics is suggestive only. The nature of the project should be such that it engages the child with interest in multidisciplinary activities. The class teachers may be the Nodal teacher for assigning the project out of the lists and models developed by the team of

teachers teaching a particular class. The review may be done periodically to ensure that it is a continuous ongoing process and not a term end review. The assessment will be done two times; once before the mid-term to see the progress and finally before the SEE. One exemplar of MDP for each class is given as annexure for reference only.

5.3 Learner's Diary on reflective practices

In order to promote the habit of reading and writing through reflection among children on regular basis, it would be appropriate to incorporate it in the assessment scheme itself. In classes VI to VIII, after completion of the topic, the child will write in his diary(separate for each subject in the form of a note-book)the following brief under three different heads:

- What I learnt: Under this head, He/she will write independently what he/she has learnt from the lesson that has just been completed. It will not be a very big composition, but may be a few sentences only based on his/ her own reflection.
- What I found challenging: The child may express freely in a few sentences the challenges/ problems that he/she encountered in the lesson/ topic taught.
- What I found interesting: The child will express freely about the interesting things that he/ she found/observed in the lesson/ experiment etc.
